
If you have tested positive for COVID-19

• Guidelines apply for <u>BOTH</u> vaccinated and unvaccinated people




If you have been exposed to COVID-19

 If you have been boosted **OR** received <u>BOTH</u> doses of your Pfizer or Moderna vaccine in the last 6 months, **OR** you received your J&J vaccine in the last two months



(If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home)

 If you have have <u>NOT</u> been vaccinated **OR** received <u>BOTH</u> your Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago **OR** you received your J&J vaccine over two months ago **OR** are not boosted



(If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home)
