Established in 1969, the Palm Beach County Library System has served the community for over 50 years expanding into 17 (soon to be 18) locations. The new Canyon Branch, located in Boynton Beach, is near completion and will be opening later this year. In addition, our Bookmobile travels to all corners of the County on a two-week rotating basis. We also offer outreach services through Talking Books and Booksby-Mail for those who have visual limitations or are physically unable to visit a Library location.

The vision of the Library is to open minds to a world of unlimited possibilities. We do this by making a welcoming environment, both physically and virtually, designed to spark creativity, stimulate thoughtful conversation and encourage collaboration. The Library provides a diverse range of activities designed to enrich, stimulate and engage members from early literacy through adulthood. Residents have free access to resources and services that reflect and engage Palm Beach County's diverse communities and residents.

A selection of Library resources includes: literacy tutoring, computer training, internet access, job seeker and small business resources, government and genealogy research, activities for children and teens, consumer health information and other means of community support and enrichment.

The Library is exploring new ways to serve the residents of Palm Beach County as our population grows and technology changes. However, we retain that personal connection to our residents when they walk through our doors. Our professional research staff assist in locating information needed for research papers, business ventures, family histories and medical conditions.

Currently, we house 1,400,000 items in our collection, all offered in various, accessible formats.






